Probably will spend 20-30 hours a week on this job - creating bi-monthly newsletter content, pushing fundraising, etc. Plan the Project Grad event - food, prizes, activities and recruit parent volunteers for the event. Speak at Senior Student assembly and Senior Parent Meeting. Communicate with Administration about various planned fundraisers and as needed throughout the year.

- **Snack Shack Team Leader** - requires posting a signup genius each month with the volunteer slots for the snack shack as well as making sure there are enough volunteers for each afternoon to work the snack shack as well as training all snack shack volunteers. This position also requires going to Sam's to purchase the items for the snack shack and then getting reimbursed from PTSO. You'll also be responsible for counting the money to make deposits into the PG account at the bank several times a week.
- **Swag Shop Team Leader** - is more of a flexible position and can be done 1x/week or more depending on schedule. You would fulfill online merchandise orders and let the parent/student know it's ready to be picked up via e-mail or text. It also requires inventorying the merchandise monthly, working with the PG team to order new merchandise 2-3x/year.

- **Fundraising position** - plan all of the fundraising events to help your Project Grad '24 raise \$60,000. Class of '23 sold coupon books and sold snacks at many school related events to raise funds.
- **Events Team Leader** - plan and prepare for New Student Invasion (sell merchandise and snacks), Open House (sell merchandise and snacks), Prospective Student Tours (sell snacks), College Fair (sell snacks), Auditions (sell snacks), New Student Registration (sell merchandise) Promote Project Graduation through signage around school and AM announcements.
- **iThink Concerts Team Leader** - Assemble a team of 10-12 volunteers to work the concerts. All must attend training at amphitheater. The concert season runs (April '23 - March '24). Potential to earn \$90/per volunteer/per concert to fundraise for Project Graduation '24.
